The Sun-Herald City2Surf is the world's largest run and Sydney's favourite sporting event. Held on the second Sunday in August, each year 85,000 participants raise over \$3.5 million for charity. The 14km course starts in Hyde Park in the CBD, up Heartbreak Hill and on to the spectacular finish at Bondi Beach. Elite runners, joggers, pushers and walkers from around the world, many dressed in novelty themed costumes take on the course, entertained along the way by live bands and DJs. The race is telecast live throughout Australia on Network Ten.
